



"Old School" Saltwater Fisherman Reveals The Secret Of Combining "Tide", "Current", And "Structure" To Stimulate Huge Strikes!

Dear Fisherman,

I'll tell ya, interviewing "Alan The Saltwater Fisherman" was probably one of the best hours I've ever spent on the phone.

Not only did he give me a boatload of easy – immediately useable tips for catching more fish in saltwater – but he gave me a few lessons about life too.

For now, I wanted to give you a quick "bulleted" summary of the technique he revealed in the interview clip. (This is for you guys that just want get right to the heart of everything, quick)

Interview : Tide, Current, and Structure - To Catch Fish

1. Knowing where the structure and current are, are extremely important
2. On the tides: the incoming tide is the best, outgoing tide is the second best (not quite as good), and the slack tide is the toughest, you really have to work to get bites with a slack tide.
3. Most saltwater species are structure oriented.
4. The game fish will find areas where their backs are to the structure and they are facing right in to an oncoming current.
5. If there is a buoy, log, or some other structure and current coming right at it, position yourself on the back side of the structure, facing the current. Then cast right over the structure so you are fishing in front of it into the incoming current. This will put your bait right in front of the game fish and will be exactly what they are looking for. They sit there waiting for bait caught in the current to carry right into them.

I hope you enjoyed the interview clip as much as I did making it. Alan is quite a guy. I couldn't thank him enough for spending time talking to me. When guys older than me talk, I listen – especially when they talk about fishing.
